- VI. School Board Liaison Report--Maryanne VanHaitsma
- Board meeting last week. Passed proclamations for Black History Month and Career Technical Education Month.
  - Funding for 200 chrome book charging lockers for elementary schools.
  - Oakland schools tech support – approved amendment to increase staff from Oakland schools for the district. Increasing support needed for increased amount of tech.
  - Secure Education Consultants (SEC) – Contract with an independent security expert to assess all schools/buildings.
  - First aid kits contract with Cintas – replenish supplies and maintain first aid kits main offices and large areas of schools.
  - Night locks – extra locking mechanism to equip and install the devices for the entire district. Meeting with vendor to determine next steps for permissions and install schedule
  - Replacing 2-way radios. Used for in school events and when outside.
  - Water testing – The district passed all tests for lead, copper, and legionella. The results can be found on the district website. <https://tinyurl.com/2p9eatn4>.
  - Wednesday night – district wellness committee. What it's like to be a teenager – challenges and discussion with a panel of teens.
  - Mask mandate – Can and encouraged to share your thoughts with the school board and principal. Administrators are assessing it. Another communication coming this week.
