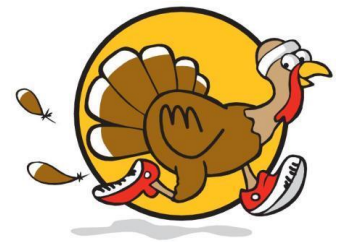


TURKEY TROT TEAM
